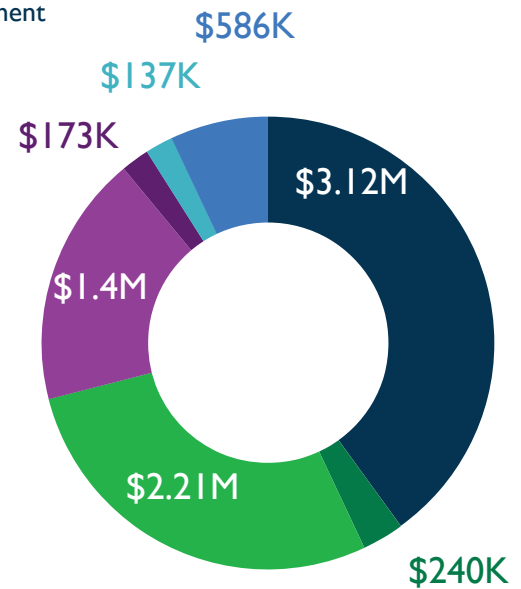


2023 Revenue Summary
